- **ARICA, CHILE** — Venture to Lauca National Park and witness the majesty of Chungará Lake, the 10th highest lake in South America. Or look out for Morro de Arica, offering a great view for those who make it to the top of this hill on the harbor.
- **BUENOS AIRES, ARGENTINA** — Visit La Boca, birthplace of Tango. Then, explore the vast cultural offerings, fine foods and quaint cafes of the city that never sleeps.
- **CABO SAN LUCAS, MEXICO** — Take a journey back in time and discover the town of Todos Santos, featuring an old Jesuit mission, shops and the Hotel California that inspired the classic Eagles song.

- **PUERTO QUETZAL, GUATEMALA** — Venture to nearby Antigua, a 90-minute trek to where 17th-century colonial facades beckon and Guatemalan history comes alive.
- **PUNTARENAS, COSTA RICA** — Stroll the seaport town with its multi-colored cottages and local markets. Head to Carara Tropical Rainforest to explore exotic flora and fauna. Or opt for a tour of San Jose — home of the Teatro Nacional and Museo del Oro.

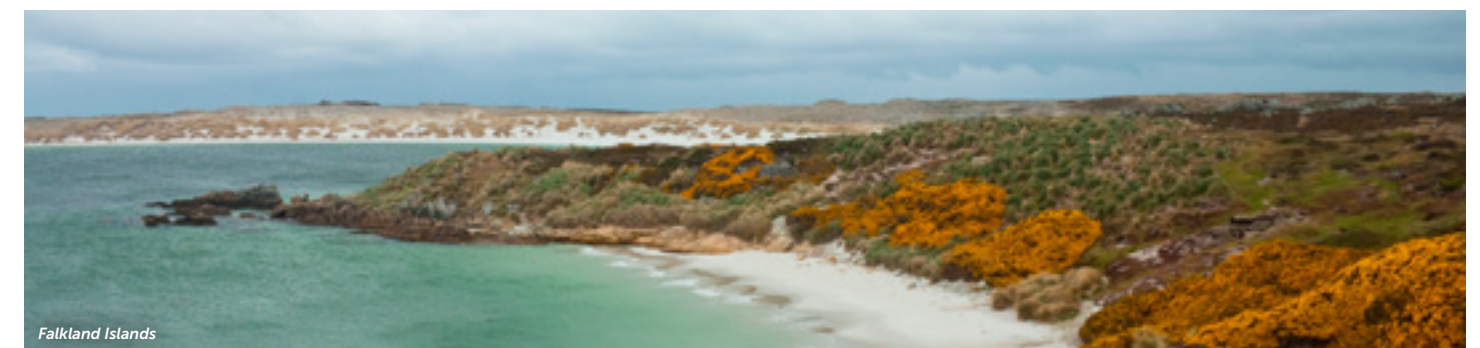

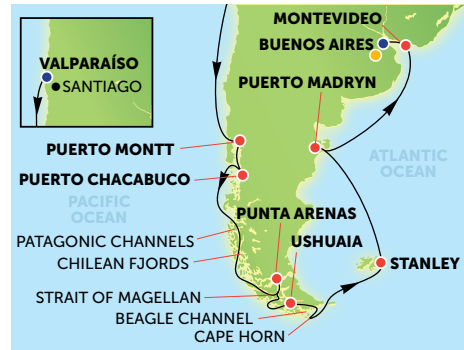

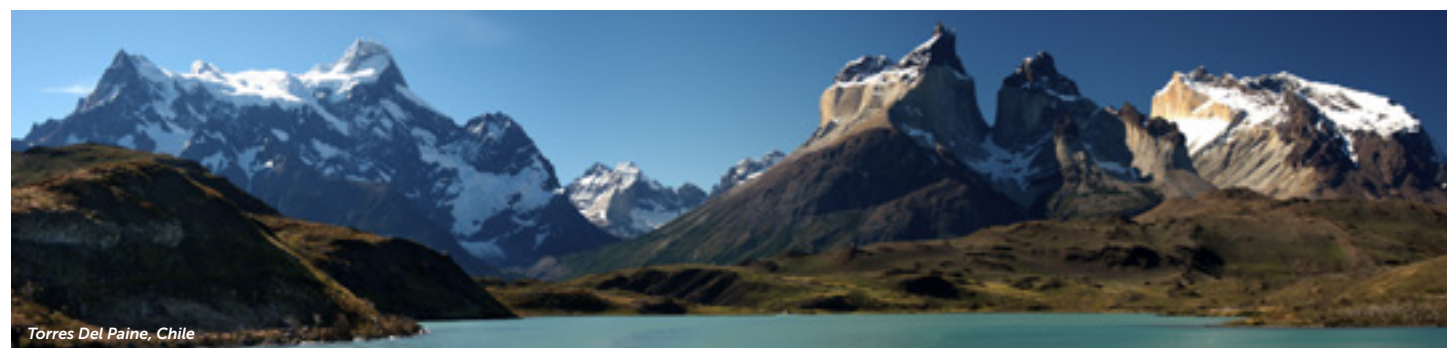

DAY 2, Wednesday - Buenos Aires/Iguazú Falls

Enjoy an early breakfast at your hotel before a transfer to the airport for your short flight to Iguazú (about 1.5 hours). Upon arrival, you'll be taken directly to Iguazú Falls National Park. Did you know Iguazú in the native Guaraní language means "great waters"? It's not surprising, considering the park consists of 275 waterfalls, portrayed as a half moon stretching 2.7 kilometers alongside the Iguazú River. During your visit, you will behold the majesty of this exquisite place from many different vantage points. Your jungle and waterfall adventure includes:
